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ENHANCING ENGLISH LANGUAGE ASSESSMENT THROUGH DIGITAL TOOLS: A COMPREHENSIVE EXPLORATION

Assessment is an essential part of any language-teaching program. It allows teachers to gauge students' progress, identify areas where they need additional support, and provide feedback.
